Civil Service Pensions will increase by 3% in 2018

Pensions in payment are reviewed each April in line with Treasury Orders. This review is called the annual Pensions Increase (PI) and takes effect on the first Monday on or after the 6 April each year. Therefore, this year, the Pensions Increase takes effect from Monday 9 April.

The Treasury Order takes account of the previous September's Consumer Prices Index (CPI) figure to determine what the adjustment will be.

Your P60 made simple

Your P60 gives you a summary of your pay and pension and the tax that's been deducted from it in the tax year. We send you a P60 to keep as a record at the end of every tax year (which runs from 6 April to 5 April the next year).

You should never destroy your P6O as it is a vital part of the proof that tax has been paid and you may also need it as proof of your income if you apply for a loan or mortgage.

This handy guide helps you to make the most of this important communication.

Remember, it is your responsibility to check your P60 and claim back any overpaid tax or report underpaid tax.

You will need to speak to HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) if you have a query about your tax code or tax liability. The HMRC contact number is 0300 200 3300.

This section will show supporting notes for your P60.



Tax year – Runs from 6 April 2017 to 5 April 2018 and includes any payments made during that period.



PAYE Reference – This is the pay as you earn reference that you should quote in any communication with HMRC.



Civil Service Pension – This is the amount of your gross Civil Service pension and the tax deducted from all taxable payments that you have received during the 2017-18 tax year.



In previous employment – HMRC advises us of any pay earned and tax paid in previous employment in the tax year: this is shown here.



Final Tax Code – This is the code that was used for your final payment in the tax year, other codes may have been used previously.



Standard lifetime allowance – HMRC sets a limit on tax relief for pensions known as the Lifetime Allowance (LTA). LTA is the maximum value of pension an individual can take from all their pension benefits before they are charged additional tax.

Have your bank details changed?

If your bank details have changed, for security reasons we are unable to update your record over the telephone.

You will need to complete the 'Change of Bank' form available on www.civilservicepensionscheme.org.uk/members under 'Member forms'.

You will also need to send in either:

- a letter from your bank on letter headed stationery which confirms the account details or
- a recent bank statement
